

- Some of the biggest misconceptions about bullying and why bullying, in itself, inadequately describes the real problem going on in schools today
- How to properly and powerfully respond to the meanest, nastiest people
- What to do when the chips are down and it feels like there is no way out
- Ways to stand up for other students when you notice they are being unfairly picked on
- Practical strategies to deal with and reduce bullying
- Tips to increase awareness and sensitivity (some students may not be fully aware they are indirectly participating in bullying)
- For bullies: giving them strong reasons to change their ways without offending or upsetting them





## Reducing Irrational Student Decisions: Getting Past Suicidal Thoughts

Suicide is a topic that Jeff takes *very* seriously. He knows what it's like to be knocked down by life and has experienced rock bottom. Studies show that suicide is the second-leading cause of death among students. Unfortunately, one in ten students have considered suicide in the past year. Here's what Jeff talks about through valuable stories and insights:

- How he dealt with the very serious feeling of wanting to kill himself after experiencing a series of unwanted setbacks, and strategies to move beyond these feelings
- Essential tips to get through the dark night of the soul, a night that is coming to students more frequently and at a younger age
- Within the context of his own journey out of the darkness, he discusses ways to successfully move past and transform darkness, fear, worry, doubt, insecurity, depression, and feelings of worthlessness
- What he realized when many of his mother's 6 and 7-year-old students at Sandy Hook Elementary School were shot and killed in December of 2012 and why it doesn't need to take a tragedy for students to value their own life
